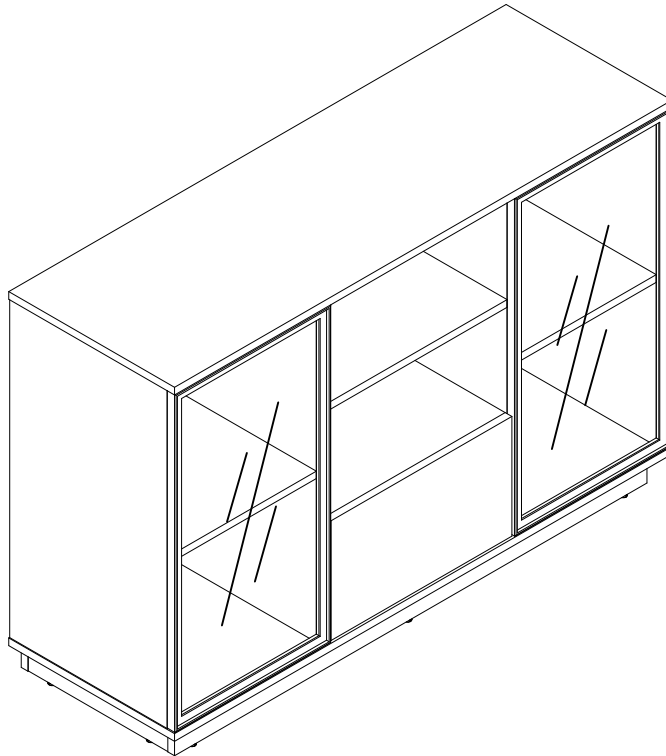

General Care:

-Keep your furniture from direct sunlight-Use desk pads and coasters to protect the surface from dents, scratches, and moisture from hot or cold liquids.

Cleaning:

-For cleaning, wipe the surface with a damp (not wet) cloth or with a clean and dry lint.

IMPORTANT - Please Read These Instructions Carefully Before Assembly.

Keep children and animals away from the work area, small parts could cause choking if swallowed.

Assemble the item as close to its intended position (in the same room) as possible.

Assemble on a soft level surface to avoid damage.

Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.

Check you have all the components and tools listed. Make sure you have enough space to layout the parts before assembly.

Do not stand or put weight on the product, which could cause damage.

Additional Tool required is screw-driver.



Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

Parts of the assembly will be easier with 2 people.

Every few months, check that there are no loose fittings on this unit.

This product should not be discarded with household waste. Take to your local authority waste disposal center.

How to use safely

Spilt liquids should be blotted rather than wiped off. This should be done immediately using a soft cloth after a spillage has occurred, then wipe it clean and dry it as stated above. It's important to carry out this procedure to prevent liquids penetrating the surface as this could cause a separation and/or splitting of the surface material.

Furniture tops may be damaged by hot plates, wet cups and objects with sharp or hard surfaces. It is recommended to use place mats.

Furniture should only be used in accordance with its structure and intended purpose of use. For your safety, the furniture should not be used as the replacement of a ladder, steps or hanger, etc.

If some parts are missing or damaged, stop using the furniture until they are replaced with the original replacements.

Doors, drawers, and shelves should not be unnecessarily left open (pulled out) as it can endanger the safety of users, especially children.

The Furniture should be placed at least 1 meter from active heat sources such as radiators and heaters. They should be used in rooms that are dry, closed and protected against the effect of atmospheric conditions including the effect of direct sunlight. Too dry or damp air may cause deformities to some parts of the furniture. Avoid placing the furniture on damp surface.

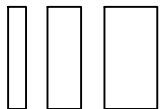
Stop using them in case of easing (unscrewing) of screws, bolts or nuts.

PRODUCT CHECK

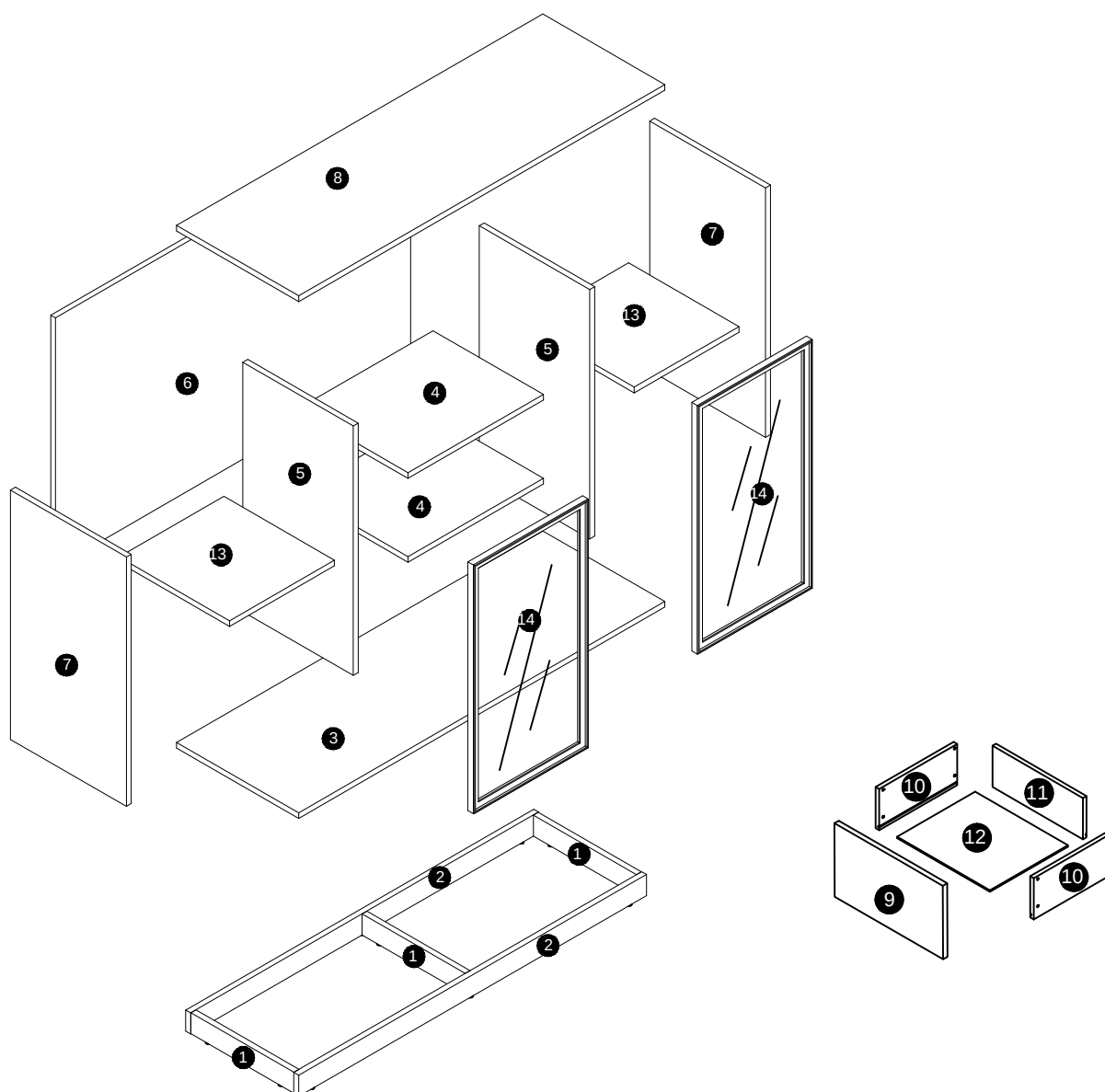
Upon receiving the furniture, please check product size, carton quantity.

The DG26-S0512 Credenza should be packaged in 2 cartons. The shipping mark to be show on 1 of 2 and 2 of 2.



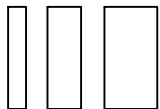

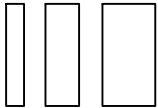
LATERAL ADJUSTMENT

the screws.

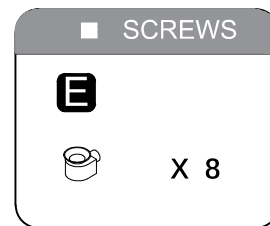
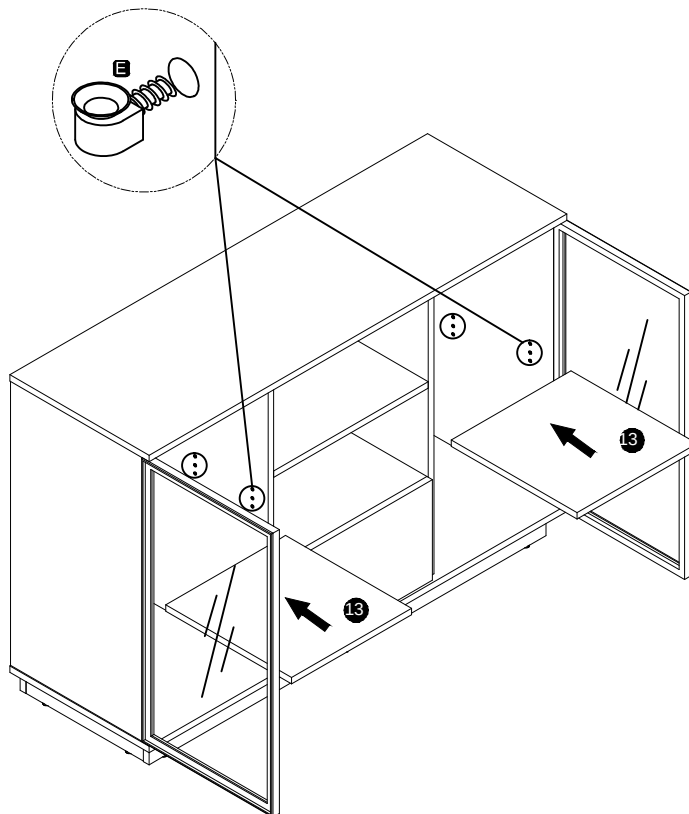

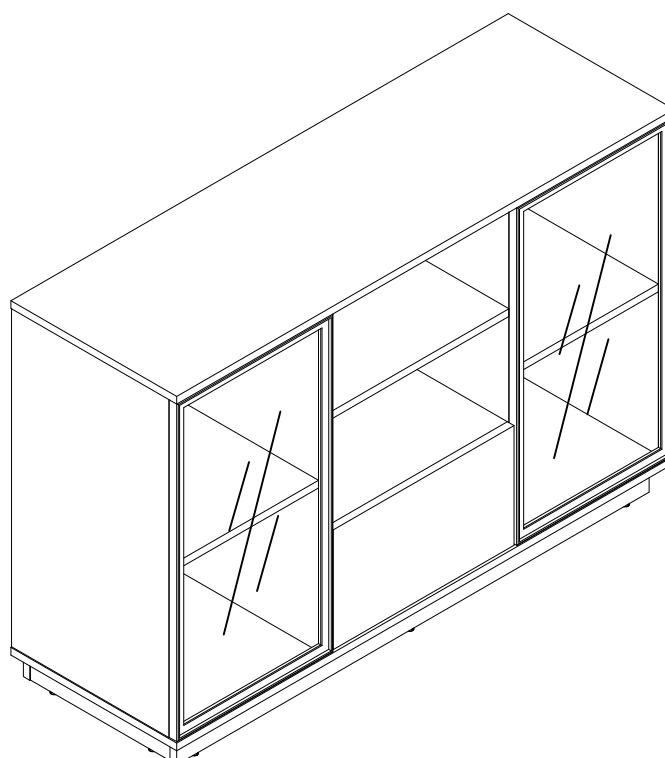

FINAL NOTE:

Do not drag the furniture as this may cause damage to the legs. Instead, ask at least 2 persons to lift carefully with caution from either end.

IMPORTANT: CARE GUIDE FOR YOUR MELAMINE BOARD FURNITURE

Please read up on important information regarding your furniture.

- Dust frequently with a clean damp, lint , free cloth.
- Avoid using chemicals or solvents when cleaning the furniture.
- Do not place hot objects on any furniture surface.
- Avoid exposing your furniture to strong sunlight.
- Do not expose your furniture to any liquids.
- Do not allow sharp or rough object scratch the surface of furniture.
- When moving furniture, do not drag it across the floor.
